GUIDELINES NEW CONVERT TUITION ASSISTANCE PLAN K - 10 Carolina Conference Schools

The "Carolina Conference Tuition Assistance Plan" is for students whose parents have been baptized into the Seventh-day Adventist Church within the last eighteen months and need financial assistance. This does not apply if one parent is a current member of the SDA Church. These students are to be enrolled in a Carolina Conference K-10 School. This does not include school students enrolled at MPA or in a Home Study Correspondence Study program.

GUIDELINES:

- The parent was baptized within the last:
 - 18 months for the first year's Education Assistance Request
 - 30 months for the second year's Education Assistance Request
 - 42 months for the third year's Education Assistance Request
 - 54 months for the third year's Education Assistance Request
- The parent is a member of a Carolina Conference Seventh-day Adventist Church.
- The parent is the legal guardian of the enrolled child.
- The application form must be voted by the church board prior to submitting the application to the Carolina Conference Office of Education.
- The Carolina Conference has a maximum budget of \$20,000 for Education Assistance. Applications will be processed in the order they are received.
