

THE STORM OF IRMA

Hurricane Irma has been an extremely powerful tropical cyclone causing severe damage to many islands of the Caribbean and Florida. It is the strongest Atlantic hurricane since Wilma of 2005 in terms of maximum sustained winds and the most intense in terms of pressure since Dean in 2007. Irma is also the first Category 5 hurricane to impact the northern Leeward Islands on record. It is the ninth named storm, fourth hurricane, and second major hurricane of the 2017 Atlantic hurricane season.

As I write this, Irma's raging storm is turning north and west of Florida and is impacting the Gulf coastline of that state. Southern Florida has already implemented evacuation plans. It's too soon to know exactly what impacts to expect in the U.S. or where they will occur. It is time for us to "Watch and Pray" as Jesus cautioned us to do in Matthew 26:41. Furthermore, it would be well for us to call on all Carolina Churches who are out of harm's way to consder becoming CHURCHES OF SHELTER & REFUGE -- especially for our Adventist families who may be displaced from their homes or unable to access hotels as a result of the looming crisis.

THE STORM OF NUCLEAR WAR THREATS

With the often referenced "rogue countries" of Iran and North Korea developing or having access to a nuclear arsenal, the world is in a more dangerous position than we have ever been in our lifetime. It is time for us to pray fervently for the leaders of our Nation and our allies as diplomatic measures are carefully weighed in the balances. Pray for peace to prevail and lives to be spared an incomprehensible holocaust.

It is in times like these that we, as Adventists, need to be aware that we are living in the very closing moments of time. I am reminded of this everytime I read this inspired counsel from God's special messger to His remnant church:

"The calamities by land and sea, the unsettled state of society, the alarms of war, are portentous. They forecast approaching events of the greatest magnitude. The agencies of evil are combining their forces and consolidating. They are strengthening for the last great crisis. Great changes are soon to take place in our world, and the final movements will be rapid ones."

3. PRAYING FOR OUR CHURCH DISTRICTS & PASTORS

Under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, these words of encouragement were penned for our churches: "Ask of me, and I will answer your requests. <u>The promise is made on condition</u> <u>that the united prayers of the church are offered, and in</u> <u>answer to these prayers there may be expected a power greater</u> <u>than that which comes in answer to private prayer.</u> The power given will be proportionate to the unity of the members and their love for God and for one another." Praying for our pastors is very important. They are serving God and the attacks of the enemy are relentless. They must be covered in prayer on a daily basis. Our prayers should be personalized by saying the title of *pastor* along with their name since they hold a position of sacred trust for God's remnant church. Here's a suggestion for this month: Why not pray for our pastors by name using these seven scriptural passages:

- 1. 2 Cor 9:8......Let all grace abound toward our pastors, having sufficiency in all things,
- 2. 2 Cor 9:8.....and an abundance for every good work.
- 3. 2 Cor 9:6......Because they have sowed bountifully, they will reap bountifully,
- 4. 1 Cor 3:6.....and whether they plant or water, Father, You give the increase.
- 5. 2 Cor 2:14.....I pray that they continually triumph in Christ.
- 6. 2 Cor 2:14...... That they diffuse the fragrance of His knowledge in every place.
- 7. Deut 28:2......That all blessings come upon them and overtake them.

Pastor Johnny Castro, one of our newest pastors to the Carolina, had the joy of baptizing four people. The Holy Spirit has been operating extraordinary miracles on the members and in the community that surrounds his Spanish church district near the Raleigh area. From July to this past Sabbath (September 9) they had two evangelistic meetings, thirteen people were baptized and they now have around 200 people attending their activity of evangelism.

Pastor Ross Knight tells the neatest story of a retired pilot named Luis and his wife Tamara who were baptized in the Elk River as members of the Banner Elk Church. They now want to dedicate their energies and their home to serving the Lord. This is the 2nd family in the last 2 years that decided to make Banner Elk their "church return" after having been away for several years. Pastor Ross says:

"It's truly amazing to see God use our little congregation, made up of mostly elderly people, to still be the witness of Christ's love to those who just simply were coaxed to walk through our doors on Sabbath for the first time in many years."

More great news! In September 3 more young people, who attend the Boone Seventh-day Adventist Church, approached Pastor Ross with the desire to be baptized.

VISION V: FOSTER A CULTURE OF SOUL WINNING IN THE CAROLINAS

PRAY AND COMMIT to leading at least 1000 new souls every year to embrace Christ and His truth as members of God's remnant church. To accomplish this, every pastor will receive encouragement and support to:



- Develop, communicate and implement an annual plan for kingdom growth in each church. This plan should intentionally include and involve the youth and young adults of the church.
- Host or personally hold at least one evangelistic/reaping effort annually in their church district. Opportunities should be explored to involve students who have participated in a *ShareHim* series of meetings.
- Follow with an extended plan of discipleship that includes an intentional involvement in the life and ministry of the church including that of being an actively engaged disciplemaker.

Jesus had one mission, and that must be the mission of His end-time church. That one mission is embodied in His recorded words of Luke 19:10 - "For the Son of Man came to seek and save the lost."

Evangelism and Discipleship must always reflect the beautiful balance of the compassionate care of Christ reflected in Matthew 25 and the compassionate call of Christ commissioned to each one of us in Matthew 28.

Let's pray and hold fast to the conviction that the Holy Spirit will bring people into the church by the power of proclaiming the truths of God's Word. However, let's also pray for the power of compassionate love in our churches to keep new believers connected to Christ and the mission of His church.

6. SATURATED WITH THE WORD

As a *President's Prayer Partner*, we again invite you to truly be a people of the Word. As Seventh-day Adventists we embrace 28 Fundamental truths that are based on the Bible alone. During the coming months, we will focus on four passages of scripture that are foundational to each of our fundamental beliefs. Here's our next set of 4 memory passages for September, to coincide with our ninth fundamental belief as Adventists on the Life, Death and Resurrection of Christ. Let's place His Word prayerfully in our hearts each day of this month.



I carry a set of these passages with me in my car and repeat them aloud as I drive from place to place. My goal is to prayerfully say one verse at least five times a day for a week, thus embracing the promise of God's Word – *"Thy Word have I hid in mine heart that I might not sin against Thee."* Psalm 119:11 Repeat these passages over and over till they become a part of your very being. Of course, you can always choose to do more. Prayerfully consider how you can saturate your soul and make His Word a part of your heart every day.

FUNDAMENTAL BELIEF # 9: The Life, Death, and Resurrection of Christ

In Christ's life of perfect obedience to God's will, His suffering, death, and resurrection, God provided the only means of atonement for human sin, so that those who by faith accept this atonement may have eternal life, and the whole creation may better understand the infinite and holy love of the Creator. This perfect atonement vindicates the righteousness of God's law and the graciousness of His character; for it both condemns our sin and provides for our forgiveness. The death of Christ is substitutionary and expiatory, reconciling and transforming. The bodily resurrection of Christ proclaims God's triumph over the forces of evil, and for those who accept the atonement assures their final victory over sin and death. It declares the Lordship of Jesus Christ, before whom every knee in heaven and on earth will bow.

- A. Isaiah 7: 14 (NKJV) "Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign; Behold a virgin shall conceive, and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel."
- B. Isaiah 9:6, 7 (KJV) "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder. And His name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. ⁷Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end."
- C. I Corinthians 15:3, 4 (NKJV) "For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures."
- D. Philippians 2:5-11 (NKJV) "Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, ⁶ who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, ⁷ but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. ⁹ Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, ¹¹ and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."
