

 - ⁹ where your fathers put me to the test and saw my works ¹⁰ for forty years. Therefore I was provoked with that generation, and said, 'They always go astray in their heart; they have not known my ways.'
 - ¹¹ As I swore in my wrath, 'They shall not enter my rest.' "

¹⁵ As it is said, "Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion."


⁴ For he has somewhere spoken of the seventh day in this way: "And God rested on the seventh day from all his works."

⁵ And again in this passage he said, "They shall not enter my rest."


Psalm 95 comments

- Hebrews 9:25-28 (ESV)
 - ²⁵ Nor was it to offer himself repeatedly, as the high priest enters the holy places every year with blood not his own,
 - ²⁶ for then he would have had to suffer repeatedly since the foundation of the world. But as it is, he has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.
 - ²⁷ And just as it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment,
 - ²⁸ so Christ, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin but to save those who are eagerly waiting for him.
