

1. PRAY FOR OUR EVANGELISM GOALS FOR 2016





5. SATURATED WITH THE WORD

With this issue of the *Presidential Prayer Partners*, we again invite you to truly be a people of the Word. Here's our sixth set of 4 memory passages for this year. Let's prayerfully place His Word in our hearts each day of this month. I carry a set of these passages with me in my car and repeat them aloud as I drive from place to place. Repeat them over and over till they become a part of your very being. Of course, you can always choose to do more. Prayerfully consider how you can saturate your soul and make His Word a part of your heart every day. *These are passages that focus on the importance of faith in our walk with Christ.*



- A. **Hebrews 11:6** (KJV) - ***“But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.”***
- B. **Ephesians 2: 8-9** (KJV) - ***“For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.***
- C. **Romans 10” 15-17** (NKJV) - ***“How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!’ But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, ‘Lord, who has believed our report?’ So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”***
- D. **I Peter 1: 8-9** (NIV) - ***“Though you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy, for you are receiving the end result of your faith, the salvation of your souls.”***

6. SEVEN GOALS FOR CAROLINA’S 2020 VISION

In just two months, elected delegates from each of our churches will assemble at Nosoca Pines Ranch to commence with the quinquennial (Five Year) business of the church in the Carolina Conference. This will include the election of its leadership in the officers, departmental directors and associates along with the new Executive Committee of the Conference. Please pray for the Holy Spirit’s leading and blessing in this session.

As your servant leader for the Lord, in collaboration with my fellow officers and departmental leaders and the endorsement of the Executive Committee of the Conference, we have embraced a 7-Point Vision of goals for God’s work between 2016 and 2020. God’s messenger to His remnant church penned these profound words of counsel in that landmark book, *Education*, Page 262:

“Success in any line demands a definite aim. He who would achieve true success in life must keep steadily in view the aim worthy of his endeavor... The heaven-appointed purpose of giving the gospel to the world in this generation is the noblest that can appeal to any human being. It opens a field of effort to everyone whose heart Christ has touched.”

Between now and August, would you partner with me in earnestly praying for these faith goals of our vision. We shared the first three with you in May, two this month, and two in July. Then the entire list in will be shared with you again in August. Here’s our next two visionary goals for God’s work in Carolina over the next 5 years:

VISION IV: ADVANCE ADVENTIST EDUCATION

PRAY AND COMMIT to increasing the number of our church schools to at least 25 [During the last quinquennial, (2011-2015) we had 19 church/conference-operated schools] with at least a 5% increase in our overall K-12 enrollment from what it is now. We embrace the Advent message that we are living in the closing moments of earth’s history. Therefore, it is our desire to advocate and validate the counsel of God’s messenger that “In the highest sense the work of education and the work of redemption are one.” *Education*, Page 20


VISION V: FOSTER A CULTURE OF SOUL WINNING

PRAY AND COMMIT to leading at least 1000 new souls every year to embrace Christ and His truth as members of God’s remnant church. To accomplish this, every pastor will receive encouragement and support to:

- Develop, communicate and implement an annual plan for kingdom growth in each church. This plan should intentionally include and involve the youth and young adults of the church.
- Host or personally hold at least one evangelistic/reaping effort annually in their church district. Opportunities should be explored to involve students who have participated in a ShareHim series of meetings.
- Follow with an extended plan of discipleship that includes an intentional involvement in the life and ministry of the church including that of being an actively engaged disciple-maker.

We hold the conviction that the Holy Spirit will bring people into the church by the power of proclaiming the truths of God’s Word. However, only the power of compassionate love will keep them connected to Christ and the mission of His church.
