



4. PRAY THAT AN EQUIVALENT OF 112 MORE CAROLINA ADVENTISTS CAME THOUGH IN DECEMBER TO COMMIT TO OUR MILLION DOLLAR EVANGELISM INITIATVE!

Did we make it? Did we give the 2017 race a final surge? As we are receiving the final reports from our 154 churches, let's pray that we reached a second milestone for evangelism by reaching our million dollar goal for souls in 2017!

TO SEEK AND SAVE THE LOST!



New plans for our 2018 GOALS FOR SOULS are being or have been developed by each of our churches. Join me in uplifting these plans for God's direction and blessing as we labor for the lives we seek to reach for Christ and His kingdom as we strive to reach our faith goal of 1000 souls for Christ's kingdom in His vineyard of the Carolinas. As of the end of November we have 631 precious new members that have been added to His remnant church in North and South Carolina. Although I am disappointed that this falls significantly short of where we were last year [100 less in kingdom growth from 2016 at this same time].

Although we don't have the final kingdom growth figures for the year through the month of December yet, I resume our shortfall may have been due to the significant number of pastoral and district changes that were necessary during the past year. Let's pray for two things – that we at least finish with a Heavenly harvest of souls close to what we ended in 2016, and that in this New Year we will witness an even more powerful outpouring of a Latter Rain of His Spirit as we continue our quest for praying for at least 1000 souls for Christ.

So how is it that we've come up with the needed number of 112 as noted on the previous page? As of the end of November, we had raised \$887,992.82 for evangelism in 2017. We are still awaiting the December totals to see that's almost 888 giving units in Carolina of \$1,000 each! So we are praying that at least 112 more generous hearts came forward in December to help us realize our goal before the end of 2017. Our November totals indicate an increase in support for evangelism by more than \$53,000 in funds from what we had at this same time last year.



That's a 6.39% gain in Evangelism Funding. Praise the Lord!!

DID WE REACH THE TOP AND MEET OUR GOALS WITH THE REPORTS FROM OUR CHURCHES DURING THIS FINAL MONTH? LET'S PRAY AS WE TABULATE OUR FINAL RESULTS FOR 2107 AND STEP FORWARD TO A NEW YEAR OF REACHING HEARTS FOR HEAVEN IN 2018.

Now let's pray for an amazing victory in Carolina for evangelism in 2018...and let's keep praying for those victory goals for Jesus every year till we see His face and hear His voice resounding say – "Well done, good and faithful Carolinians!" One Million Evangelism Dollars and One Thousand Precious Souls for Christ's Kingdom in the Carolinas! Oh what glory that will be for HIM!

1. VISION I: ESTABLISH NEW CHURCH PLANTS

PRAY AND COMMIT to a FAITH GOAL of raising at least 20 New Church Plants in South Carolina and 40 in North Carolina.

In addition PRAY and COMMIT to a FAITH GOAL of 90 TOTAL progressions or steps in congregational status [GROUPS transitioning to COMPANIES; COMPANIES transitioning to become organized CHURCHES].

6. SATURATED WITH THE WORD

As a *President's Prayer Partner*, we again invite you to truly be a people of the Word. As Seventh-day Adventists we embrace 28 Fundamental truths that are based on the Bible alone. During the coming months, we will focus on four passages of scripture each month that are foundational to each of our fundamental beliefs. Here's our next set of 4 memory passages for September to coincide with our twelfth fundamental belief as Adventists regarding what we believe about the church as God's ordained family of faithful believers. Let's place His Word prayerfully in our hearts each day of this month.



I carry a set of these passages with me in my car and repeat them aloud as I drive from place to place. My goal is to prayerfully say one verse at least five times a day for a week, thus embracing the promise of God's Word – "Thy Word have I hid in mine heart that I might not sin against Thee." Psalm 119:11. Repeat these passages over and over till they become a part of your very being. Of course, you can always choose to do more. Prayerfully consider how you can saturate your soul and make His Word a part of your heart every day.

FUNDAMENTAL BELIEF # 12: The Church

The church is the community of believers who confess Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour. In continuity with the people of God in Old Testament times, we are called out from the world; and we join together for worship, for fellowship, for instruction in the Word, for the celebration of the Lord's Supper, for service to humanity, and for the worldwide proclamation of the gospel. The church derives its authority from Christ, who is the incarnate Word revealed in the Scriptures. The church is God's family; adopted by Him as children, its members live on the basis of the new covenant. The church is the body of Christ, a community of faith of which Christ Himself is the Head. The church is the bride for whom Christ died that He might sanctify and cleanse her. At His return in triumph, He will present her to Himself a glorious church, the faithful of all the ages, the purchase of His blood, not having spot or wrinkle, but holy and without blemish.

- A. Exodus 19:5-6 (NKJV) "Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine. ⁶ And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation."
- B. Ephesians 2:19-22 (NIV) "Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also members of his household, ²⁰ built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone. ²¹ In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. ²² And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit."
- C. I Peter 2:9 (KJV) -"But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light."

- D. I John 1:7 (NKJV)-"But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin."
