DISCIPLESHIP



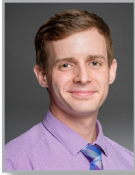

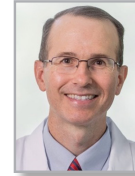

Directly across from Lake Junaluska is the 18-hole Junaluska Golf Course, which spans 5,034 yards and has a par of 68.

Aquatic Center

The Lake Junaluska Aquatic Center is open daily from 10:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m. Cost: Pool: \$10/person, \$30/family of 4 (free for guests booked through Lake Junaluska; wristbands given at check-in).

Recreation Hut

Mini-golf, Shuffleboard and Corn Hole: \$5/game; Boat rentals: \$10/1 hr. Available at the Recreation Hut in the pool area.

Boat Tour

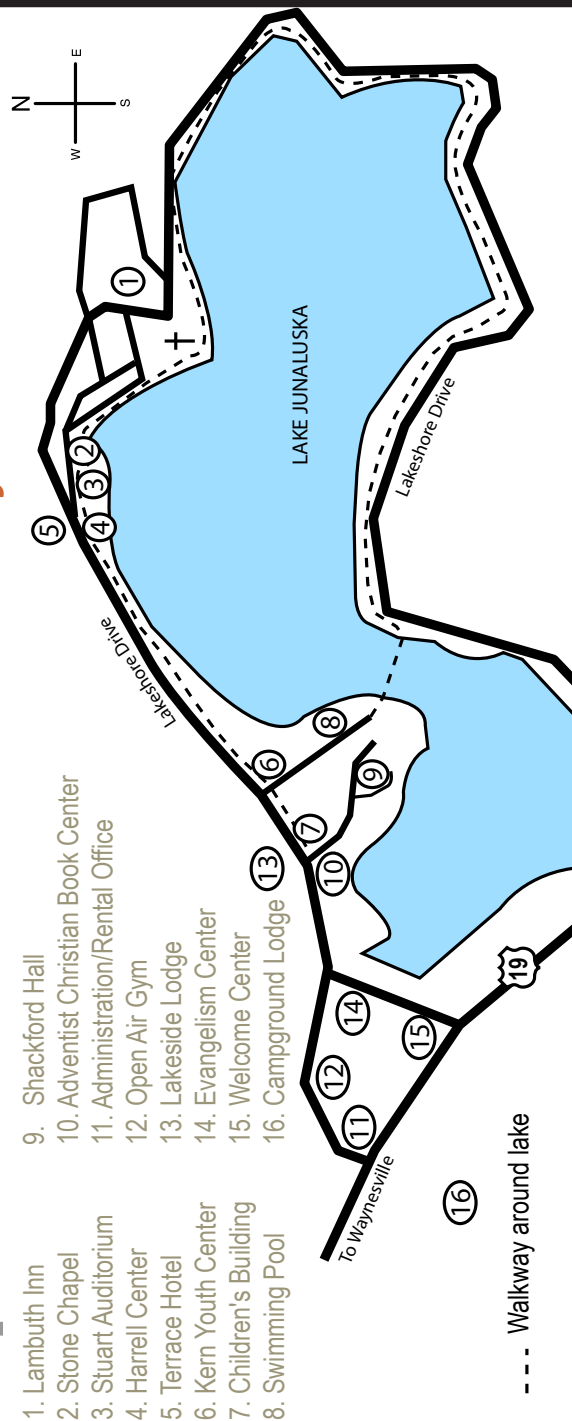
